You are currently a PhD student and you are fully focused on your research project.

You do not yet anticipate "the after-thesis". You think that this is not really your priority for the moment, and that you will think about it after completing your PhD ?

If this is your case, this document/ landmarks is for you : you will find in it useful information, recommendations, advice, and also specialized resources.

To **optimize** your career development and **succeed** in your **transition after the PhD**, regardless of your project/objective, it is important that you explore the options and possibilities upfront, and start preparing from your D2, as well as throughout your journey as a PhD student : you need to be **proactive**, combine **reflection** with **actions** on your multiple skills, the added value of your doctoral experience, your interests, your values, your career paths ...

The idea is to fully integrate this strategic activity into your roadmap and your plan, and ensure that you are the main decision-maker on these matters.

the after doctorate is built and **developed during the PhD**, in conjunction with your research activity.

Be interested, through the **offer** of **training of the Doctoral College** and your doctoral school (ED), to anything that can boost your thinking about your skills, the enhancement of your experience developed during your thesis, your PhD added-value, your career prospects ...



+ Adopt the **network approach** :

create personalized opportunities, initiate contacts and exchanges with professionals and conduct interviews to specify / validate your project, to find out about a trade or a sector of activity, get feedback on your positioning and get advice and other contacts

+ Dare to **network outside** your **academic environment**, multiply and diversify opportunities: trade fairs, forums, networking events, seminars, challenge operations ...

+ Optimize your profile on **professional social media** (LinkedIn etc.) actively, identify opportunities and make sure your profile is visible and readable.

+ Identify **career paths of PhDs** who pursue their careers **outside academia**, in order to expand your range of possibilities.

+ Participate in **other activities** outside research and add more experiments during your PhD : for example by taking part in actions and projects led by PhD student associations.



Organize your **own watch** and monitor closely the market : get informed on the trends of the private and public sectors of activity, recruitment, job opportunities, professions, strategy for job search ...
